Policy for 0% recorded llamas

The Breeder/owner completes the application form.

The fee for recording at 0% is \$51 + GST.

Prior to applying for recording the breeder will have the animal microchipped and shall provide a DNA profile for the purpose of future parent verification requirements. The applicant shall also declare on the application that all known ancestors are of the same breed, and that the subject animal meets the Association's minimum breed standards for the breed.

Both the application form and fee should be mailed to the Canadian Livestock Records in Ottawa.

Should a foreign pedigree exist for a 0% recorded llama all available information such as foreign registered names, foreign pedigree and registration numbers shall be recorded and printed on the certificate of any Percentage Purebred llama resulting from the breeding of this 0% recorded llama.

Should the subject animal possess a foreign registry certificate a copy of that certificate should accompany the application form.

For the offspring of a 0% recorded llama to be registered as 50% purebred, the 0% llama must first have been mated with a CLAA Foundation Stock or Purebred male or female.
